Audubon's 290-acre sanctuary is an ideal place for children entering kindergarten through grade 9 to develop an appreciation for and understanding of the environment. Join us for seven fun-filled weeks of hands-on, educational hikes, games, activities and crafts!

Seven one-week sessions take place June 28–August 13 from 9:30 a.m.-3:30 p.m. Camps for teens entering grades 6-9 are offered during the weeks of June 28, July 12 & 26 and August 9.

Camp Themes include: Creepy Crawlies, Twilight Investigations, Backwoods Explorers, Scales & Tails, Aquatic Adventures and Audubon Ecology Adventures (grades 6-9 only).

Twilight Investigations (August 9-13) is an evening camp that runs from 4-9 p.m. There is no day camp during this week. On Thursday (8/12) night, campers entering grades 4-9 will have an overnight at the Audubon Center and get picked up on Friday (8/13) at 9:30 a.m. Campers in grades K-3 will attend camp from 4-9 p.m. for the entire week (Monday-Friday).

The cost is \$315 for Audubon members; \$350 for non-members (includes \$35 annual family membership fee). For the week of July 6-9 (no camp on July 5), the cost is \$252. *We do not offer sibling or multiple week discounts.*

Each group has one Head Summer Naturalist and one Assistant Summer Naturalist. There will be 1-3 Counselors-in-Training working with each group throughout the summer.
