The Williams School offers five camps for boys and girls during the summer. Join us for art, robotics & engineering design, basketball, soccer, and/or lacrosse!

W.I.R.E.D. - *Williams Introduction to Robotics and Engineering Design*: A weeklong, half day program utilizing the Lego® EV3 robotics system and Lego® Mindstorm software for hands-on design, construction, and coding of autonomous and remote controlled robots. For ages 10-14,

Summer Art Camp - There are two sessions offered, Choose from: *Art Meets Science*: Explore a variety of art media through hands-on investigations or *Fashion Design*: Take your ideas through the drawing and design stage and then create the actual clothing. For ages 10-14.

Lacrosse Camp, grades 3-10, Sessions stress individualized instruction in stick handling, shooting and offensive/defensive play. Each session promotes a player's development through a comprehensive teaching progression allowing the campers to learn every aspect of the game. By week's end, players will participate in team games.
