The Summer Institute is open to all students from any school and runs June 12-August 4. In years past, students from more than 20 different schools attended Summer Institute, located on King's 34-acre North Stamford campus.

Academics, Performing & Creative Arts, and Sports offerings vary for Grades 1-12. Children entering Kindergarten - Grade 6 can experience "Fun Camp." The Upper School and Middle School Programs allow students to take courses to enrich their academic experiences or to accelerate their programs in the next academic year. SI Director Brian Coughlan oversees course selection, collaborating with King Division Heads and Department Chairs on the needs and requests of students who are enrolled in SI. "With dozens of classes to choose from, the Summer Institute offers something to suit the individual strengths and talents of each student. The large variety of classes allows students to make selections that match their interests instead of opting for one-size-fits-all program," Coughlan said.

The Fun Camp introduces a new "summer specialty" each week and the Sports camps offer, basketball, volleyball, boys lacrosse, baseball, field hockey and mountain biking programs. Take advantage of these great programs and spend a week outside, or on the court, mastering new skills.

Summer Institute Performing & Creative Arts Camps are held in King's Performing Arts Center. Offerings include public speaking, mask making, technical theater, piano, singing, and dance.

Members of King's outstanding Faculty teach the majority of programs. Small class size ensures that your son or daughter will receive the kind of personalized attention King delivers year round.
