Camp Hemlocks – Unique people and a unique experience

Easterseals Camp Hemlocks offers residential summer camping for youth and adults with physical, sensory, and developmental disabilities in the scenic woods of Central Connecticut.

Newly renovated by Oak Hill in 2015, Camp Hemlocks is located on 160 acres in Amston, CT, being originally completed in 1974 with an expansion in 1987. It is a facility for providing education and residential summer camping. Featuring Barrier free design, it is an environment allowing people with disabilities complete access and optimal independence, while permitting maximum participation, including a fully handicap-accessible 60'x40' indoor pool. The facility is approximately 50,000 sq. ft., with large meeting rooms, dining room capacity for 150, overnight accommodations for 100, an open air pavilion, and three lodges. There is also a 22 acre lake on the property which is used for boating and fishing.

Meeting space is available to local community and civic groups and it can now be utilized as a 12 month facility. Programs may include, but, are not limited to: summer camp; Nature's Classroom; collaboration with Special Olympics; work with veterans; and, an adaptive sports program.
