Waldorf Summer Camp is a day camp for boys and girls ages 3-14, divided into two age groups — ages 3-7 and 8-14. The camp offers a full day program. We offer a variety of quality activities and special programs led by talented and dedicated educators. Waldorf will give your child summer days with the right balance of activities and relaxation — filled with discovery, creativity, imagination and the opportunity to simply “be a kid”.

Our programs emphasize activities that are developmentally appropriate and designed to meet and challenge each child in a healthful and fun way. The program that serves our younger campers will nourish your child’s inherent connection to nature and enliven their sense of wonder with handcrafts, art, free play and nature exploration. Other activities include cooking with organic ingredients, gardening, watercolor painting, fort building, water play and cooperative games.

The children that attend the older age camp will experience more specific instruction activities. They can sign up for weeks that will allow them to explore the sport of archery from basic skills to more advanced shooting and challenging styles. We offer a week of “circus arts” that allow children to challenge themselves physically with our professional circus arts instructor. Also, discover, explore and engage in different methods and mediums of creative artistic expression.
