Hamden Hall Country Day School offers a comprehensive summer program that provides a wide range of activities and enrichment opportunities for children entering PreSchool through Grade 12. The summer program is in session **June 11 through August 3**.

Camp Hornet offers daily swim lessons, group games, arts and crafts, sports and themed activities, and local field trips. Camp is held at the Beckerman Athletic Center located on Skiff Street in Hamden. This 8-week program (June 11 through August 3) runs weekdays from 9 a.m.-3:30 p.m., with both morning and afternoon extended day coverage.

Summer Academy, which is held on our Whitney Avenue Campus, offers a variety of enrichment workshops and classes, study skills programs, and preview/review courses in core subject areas. Credit courses are also available. This six-week program runs June 25 through August 3.

Sports Camps offer the aspiring athlete the opportunity to improve individual skills or learn the basic skills of a new sport. A wide variety of camps are available including Basketball, Soccer, Tennis and Lacrosse. An extra week of Basketball Camp is offered Aug. 6 through Aug. 10 by Hamden Hall Boys' Head Coach (and former QU assistant coach) Sean Doherty.

Early Childhood Discovery Program is designed for children 3 to 5 years old and features weekly themed adventures in storytelling, music, art, learning garden, science, water play, cooking, and local age-appropriate field trips. Register for one week or all nine. This program runs from June 11 through Aug. 10, weekdays 8 a.m.-3:30 p.m., with an extended day option.
