Hopkins School offers summer programs for students entering grades 3-12, with sessions running from June 25-August 3, 2018.

The Middle and Upper Summer school courses provide a wide variety of academic and enrichment courses for students entering grades 7-12 in the fall. The Upper School program offers SAT review and chess, as well as courses for academic credit and non-credit academic review. Enrichment courses are for students seeking to expand their horizons or strengthen core learning skills. For students entering 7th to 8th grade, courses in Expository and Creative Writing, Pre-algebra and Computer Programming are offered. These classes are challenging, experiential and fun.

The Lower School program is an age-appropriate learning and enrichment program for students entering grades 3-6 in the fall. Courses in math, computers, reading, writing and chess are all available.

The Hopkins Squash Camp is a coeducational instruction program that offers students an opportunity to strengthen foundation skills while acquiring the techniques necessary to improve or excel in the sport.
